Courses

The Center for Writing and libraries at the University of Iceland offer a variety of courses to help students and staff to find and work with sources, write essays and theses, and work smart.

The courses are open to all students at the university unless otherwise advertised.

Course examples:

One-on-one sessions

The Center for Writing offers one-on-one or small group writing consultations. Consultations take place on the second floor of the National and University Library, in the School of Education library in Stakkahlíð, or on Teams.



From the first class assignment to the final thesis, all students are welcome to book a session with a peer tutor at the center. You can book via the center's website. The libraries at the School of Education and the School of Health Sciences along with the National and University Library invite individuals and small groups to book a session to find sources for their academic work.

Center for Writing workshops

Workshops are a great way for people to come together for mutual support at all stages of writing, from the research question to the final draft. Participants can share ideas and give each other advice on their work.

The Center for Writing offers workshops in both English and Icelandic for students who are writing their theses. These are open to all students at the University of Iceland.

The center also offers a variety of workshops, writing seminars, and retreats for master's and PhD students from all schools at the university.
